There will be a mandatory pre-race veterinarian exam with Dr Giunta and Dr Beattle . Exams will start at 8 am for first race horses. Bandages are not permitted during the examination.

LASIX HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 4 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THEIR SCHEDULED RACE. ALL HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 2 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THE FIRST RACE UNLESS EXCUSED BY THE STEWARDS FOR EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES.

Foal papers are not required to be on file with the Horse Identifier at the races providing the horse can be properly identified; and tattoos or microchips are required for all horses, with a one-time exception providing the horse can be identified by his/her markings. All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race.

Course Report:
The Foxfield Turf Course was inspected by Jack Sanford and Reynolds Cowles.

The turf is 6-7 inches in height, very smooth and consistent.
Turf type: fescue. Height will be clipped to 6 1/2 inches mid week. The course has been consistently irrigated for the past 4 weeks and natural rainfall has been ample.

Compaction measured with Longchamp penetrometer, averages 1.72 inches (4.3 cm), which equals the soft side of good.

Moisture averages 32.9% with a TDR which is on the good side of soft. We have showers predicted the day before the races and on race day.

The course will be measured again mid week and this report will be updated if there is any change.
